



Worldwide: 4.3 million students



- 2 electives

- International Degree Programmes: IELTS / TOFEL
- Regular Degree Programmes: TestDaF / DSH

- Apply one by one
- No service charge
- Flexibility in admission

*refer to university websites for more details

Via UNI-ASSIST

- Preliminary check on behalf of the university
- Can apply more than one university at one time
- 68 Euro for the first application,
 15 Euro each for more applications

5 Steps to Germany...

Online application

Certify all certificates and transcripts

Mail the application documents in hardcopy to Germany before deadline

Receive acceptance letter

Apply student visa

Germany – What does it cost?

- Average cost of living:
 650 850 Euro per month
- Tuition Fees:
 None for public universities
- Part-time jobs allowed:
 120 full days /240 days half days
- Job after completion of studies: up to 18 months to look for a job matching their qualification



The Way to Germany

Visa

- Student visa necessary
- Passport, university's admission letter, proof of sufficient financial means
- Health insurance certificate
