



Merit& Demerit of Study in Japan (Japan Society)

日本的社會

【好處】

- ◆ 安全・安心・清潔・準確(精細)・信用
- ◆ 良質的服務(日式的招待: Omotenashi)
- ◆ 以中國古代文化為基礎發展的日本文化→有部分漢字的意思不同
- ◆ 開發成熟的先進技術,社會環境
- ◆ 可以加入日本的國民健康保險、只是需負担30%的醫療費
- ◆ 留學簽證的放寬 (日本語學校 最長2年3個月 大學最長4年3個月、 許可做兼職 可自由出入境)

【壞處】

- ◆ 物價比較高
- ◆需要日語
- ◆生活習慣不同 (好處的反面,嚴緊的社會規則和時間規限,強制性的人際關係, 冷漠感=不大方)

Merit& Demerit of Study in Japan (University, School)

大學・學校

【好處】

- ◆ 日本的大學歓迎留學生
- ◆ 有範圍廣泛的各種學科領域課程, 也有英語課程→學校選択
- ◆ 相對學費比較便宜

國立大學:第1年80萬円 第2年開始50萬円

私立大學:第1年【文科】120萬円 第2年開始80萬円

【理系】150萬円 第2年開始90~110萬円

- ◆ 比較容易拿到奨學金(比例 大學生60% 46,000円/月)
- ◆ 可做兼職 (28時間/週 900円/時×20時間/週×4週/月=72,000円)
- ◆ 日本也可以就業 (有時候留學生比較有利)

【壞處】

- ◆ 需要日語(有英語課程,但生活也需要日語)
- ◆ 所有的自我責任(=自由), 需要自己管理能力
- ◆ 與日本人同學做真正朋友要花時間(一般的意見)
- ◆ 考學費便宜的國立大學,要求報考科目比較多(日語 理科 社會 英語)










