
#### **Applying Procedure**

# Work in Taiwan

#### **Taking Part-time Jobs**

Foreign Students
Overseas Chinese Students



Attend a College, University or Language program in Taiwan for 1 year



Have an excellent academic record



#### **Required Documents:**

- Application fee (NTD100)
- 2. Application Form
- 3. Photocopy of student ID
- 4. Photocopy of valid passport permit
- 5. Transcript of language course taken for over 1 year
- 6. Foreign students with one of the following conditions should attach one of the following related documents:
- (1) Those who cannot financially maintain educational and daily expenses and can provide concrete proof.
- (2) Those attending school's research unit requiring foreign student assistance and work participation.
  - (3) Those required to engage in extracurricular internship related to attended courses.
- (4) Those in graduate school and approved by the school to engage in research related to attended courses.
- \* With the exception of the winter and summer vacations, foreign students' sum of working hours shall not exceed 20 hours per week.

## Students graduated in Taiwan and prepare to work

#### Foreign Employee Qualification:

- 1. have a Bachelor or higher degree in Taiwan
- 2. employment permits score above 70 points



#### **Employer Qualification:**

The employer should meet the qualification under employing foreigners for specialized or technical works, such as qualification for franchising business, capital amount, turnover, etc.



#### Comment Item:

- Education
- 2. Salary
- 3. Work Experience
- Qualified to serve in relevant capacity
- 5. Chinese proficiency
- 6. Multi-lingual Ability
- 7. Personal overseas development
- 8. Compliance with government policy



#### **Required Documents:**

- 1. Application Form
- Name List of the employed foreign workers
- 3. Comment system comment form and documents in compliance with each comment item
- Photocopy of the passport or ARC, degree certification, employment contract
- Others




