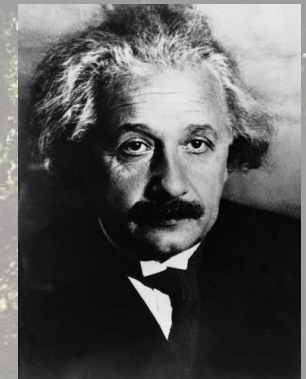

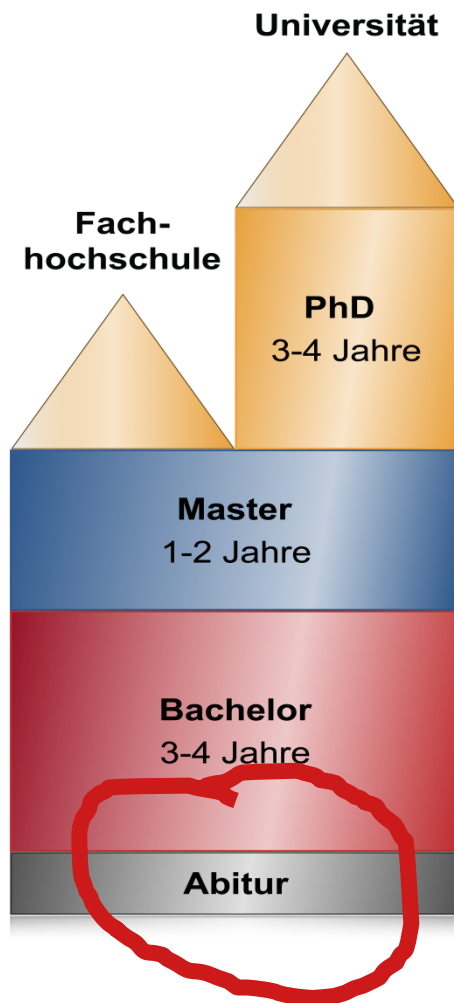


# Good reasons for studying in Germany

- After graduation, you will have 18 months of time to find a job
- Generally no study fees



# The current German Degree System at a glance



- Bachelor's Degree (3 and 4-year programmes)
- Master's Degree (1; 1,5 and 2-year programmes)
- BA/BSc and MA/MSc consecutive 5 years
- PhD Degree (3 to 5 years, structured programme or individual doctorate)
- State Exams for the medical and legal professions

Set course groups, stronger student-professor relationship

Often smaller regional universities

Total number: 52

Focus on practical application

Admission often based on portfolios and aptitude tests

Artistic subjects such as design, graphics, music, camera work

Very international student population

Degrees available: Bachelor's, Master's, State Exam, PhD

# Private Universities Important: check for state accreditation!

Total number: 126

Primarily universities of applied sciences

Programmes mostly in business administration, etc.

Small classes, and state-of-the-art technology

Close ties to industry

A significant international dimension

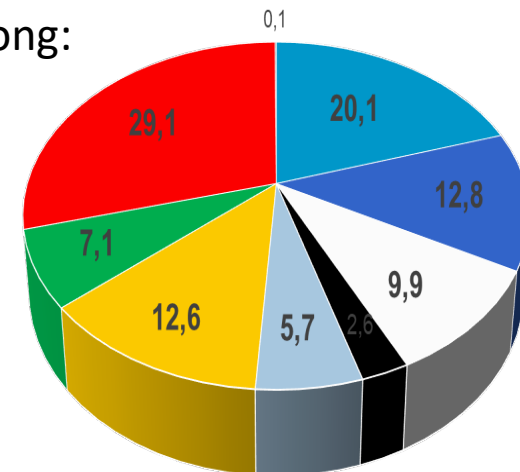
Degrees available: Bachelor's, Master's, occasionally PhD

Sometimes high tuition fees



## Foreign Nationals Studying in Germany in 2017

- Germany has more than 2.8 million students in total, 12.8% of them from abroad (appr. 360,000), figures rising.
- Most of these foreign students come from China, Eastern Europe or Western Europe.
- Academic Year 2018/2019 students from Hong Kong:  
Bachelor students 47, Master students 123;  
PhD Students 24

## Costs of Living in Kleve and Kamp-Lintfort

### Average living costs

The Student Service Organisation in Germany has prepared an overview about the average living costs in Germany. You can find this overview [here](#). Another cost overview for students can be found here: [Study in Germany](#). The average living costs for a student in Germany are estimated to be around **€ 850 per month**.

This includes expenses for:

- Rent and utilities (heating, electricity, internet, waste removal)
- Mandatory student health insurance
- Food, clothing
- Leisure time activities
- Additional taxes and fees (see below for details)



## Working while Studying

- Many students supplement parental support, student loans or scholarships with a part-time job.
- Non-EU citizens who do not have work permits may work for 120 full days or 240 half-days – more if they have jobs as student or graduate assistants.
- Whatever jobs they have need to be reported to the foreigners authority.

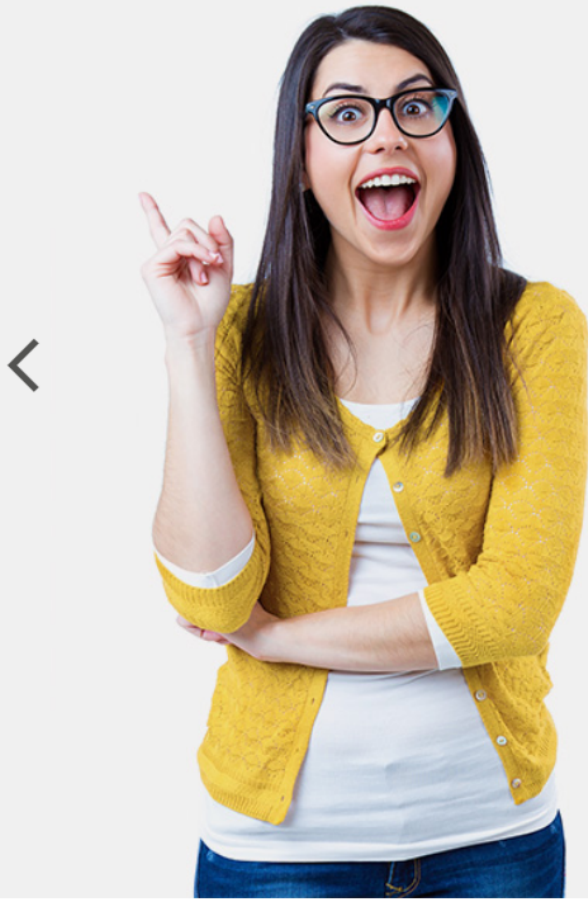

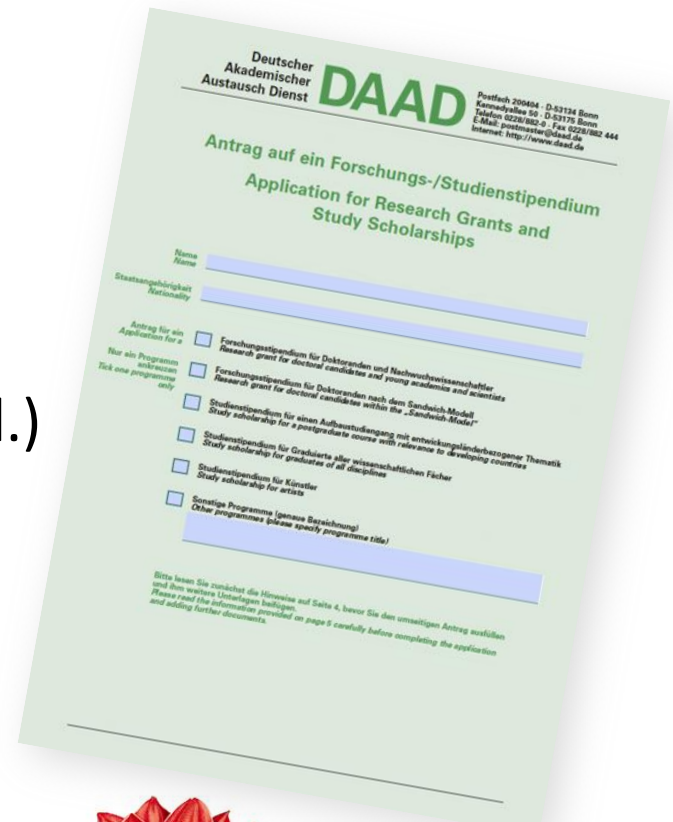

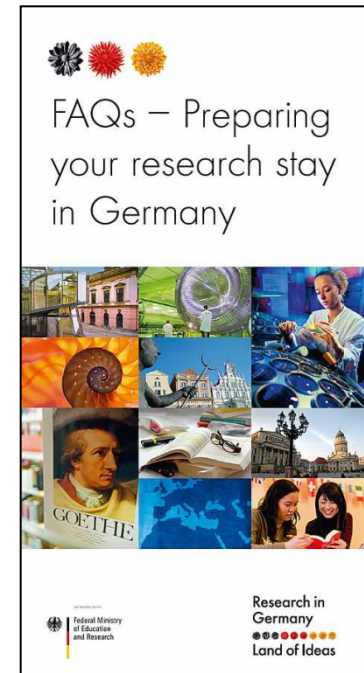
