- Most 3 years' duration (4 years in Scotland)
- Options for 4 years' duration
- 5 6 years' duration (Clinical courses) Postgraduate courses
 - 1 to 2 years' duration (MA/MSc/MPhil)
 - 3+ years' duration (PhD)


