What is Career-related Experiences?

It encompasses a broad range of serial programmes/ activities organised by school for their students. With the assistance of professionals (e.g. business mentors), students would enrich their experiences, acquire up-to-date knowledge about "the world of work", enhance their understanding on employability and work ethics, and reflect on their career aspirations and development.





一些注意事項(1)


- 重心是學習,而不是「擇業」

-些注意事項(2)


- 善用夥伴關係網絡,促進有效學習

 - 扼要表述, **不需「鉅細無遺**」


